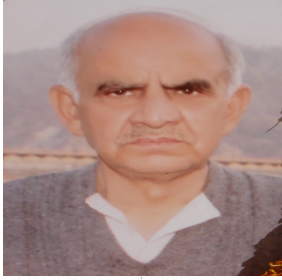

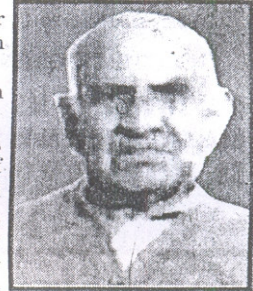


!! SHRADHANJALI !!

After completing his schooling he did his BSe at Srinagar and joined the department of Education as a teacher. He completed his B.Ed during service.

He got married to Phoola daughter of late Shri Janki Nath Mattoo resident of Karan Nagar, Srinagar in 1958. He had four daughters and a son whom he provided good education and all of them are well settled. Due to turmoil in the Valley the family migrated from Srinagar and settled at Jammu. He was a very intelligent, efficient and a dedicated teacher. He had good reputation in the department and got accelerated promotions. He retired from service as Zonal Education Officer in 1996. He also participated in religious and other social activities and helped the poor and needy persons. He breathed his last on 30th September 2009 due to liver cancer. He is survived by his wife, four daughters and a son.

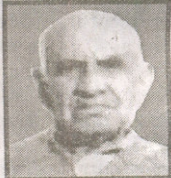
MOURNING FROM IN-LAWS SIDE

It is a tragedy, indeed. In June he was detected with cancer, secondaries in liver and extended to bones, lumber 2,3 & 4; he was put on mild chemotherapy and given radiotherapy on the spine. As expected his condition deteriorated gradually. During the last week of his life, however, he had agonizing pain with no relief despite pathedine injections.

I had personal equation with him, for, I was the one who had gone in Feb 1957 to his house with "Sagan" on engagement ceremony.

My last meeting with him lasted only a few minutes because I simply could not bear the agonising pain that he was going thru. I simply admired and loved him all my life. In return he always liked me among all the members of the clan (that's the feeling he always gave me).
